

CM Robinson 10.21.24 blog reply points

- Swiminc budget fully disclosed
- American Red Cross audit facts and timeline fully disclosed
- Management practices – CM Robinson's relentless attacks on current Executive Director, Steve Hawkins, beginning with continued mischaracterization of a simple and inconsequential conversation and action to submit a training course roster. (SH asked Ee, Ee declined, SH agreed to take care of submission)
- \$175,000 income figure 2023 Swiminc to Kurt Carmen a manipulative misrepresentation to fit Council Member Robinson's narrative.
 - Kurt Carmen 2023 Swiminc salary \$98,500
 - All consultation fees checks made payable to Ohio Aquatic Council, as a contracted business entity, 2023 total \$68,958.75.
- ODNR representation directly consulted to verify OAC consultation fees were permissibly eligible and compliant. ODNR affirmed and accepted the submission. Now Council Member Robinson assumes to call this government institution into question?
- Former Director of Aquatics, referred to as General Manager, **NOT** fired. Her position in the organization was eliminated as a reduction in force achieving a more responsible org-chart and elimination of staff redundancies.
- The “General Manager” email displayed in blog with a redacted To: addressee left blank was clearly **addressed to Lori Ave**, the former Director of Aquatics, in the original unedited communication. It also clearly states “effective as of the date of this email, **your** Instructor Agreement hereby terminated, and **you** are no longer permitted to teach any Red Cross course or hold **yourself** out as authorized to teach any such course. These various tenses of you clearly in regard to the recipient Lori Ave. The alleged confusion is a weak excuse. A responsible orator of truth would have verified facts.
