The App is searchable in the App Store under "Worthington Pools" and is abbreviated as "WoPo (JR)"

Login to your account to register for classes and programs, stay updated on the schedule and keep track of previous classes taken.

We encourage everyone to download the App before the first day of classes. Students should be prepared and know which level they've registered for.

A reminder: Worthington Schools get priority water time in the indoor pool. Lessons will not happen on days of competitive meets, but the number of classes will be a complete session.

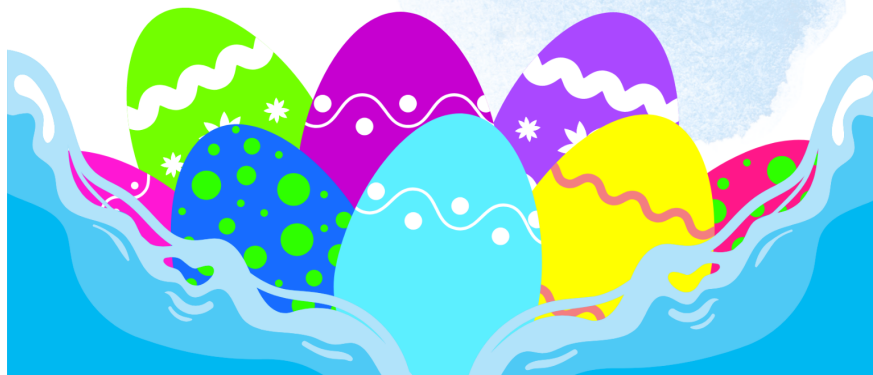

Pay at the Door



We're having our annual Easter egg hunt in the indoor Natatorium on Saturday, April 8th. Children ages 0-6 can hunt for eggs at 12pm, and children ages 6 and above have their turn at 1pm.

From 12pm-2pm the pool will be available for an Open Swim for anyone not participating in the egg hunt. It is \$8 per egg hunter and payment is taken at the door starting at 11:30am.

Bring strainers, colanders or butterfly nets to gather your eggs in the water! Lifejackets will be given to swimmers by the discretion of the pool staff.
